

Instructions for authors

1. An engineering paper should show a solution to an engineering problem.
2. An engineering paper has to be free of excessive commercialism. Company/product names, logos, trademarks must not be included into paper titles and abstracts. Within the paper text, the company/product names or trademarks used to perform the discussed work have to be reduced to a minimum, necessary to understand it. Besides that, they can be referenced in the literature sources or in the acknowledgement section. Images produced with commercial software can be used, but without software frame, logo, name or trademark seen on them.
3. The full papers submitted for a publication have to have 4 to 10 pages in length according to the format of template available at <http://mes2018.aua.am/paper/>.
4. The short papers between 2 and 4 pages in length will be considered for poster session.
5. Submitting a paper together with its full translation in the other working language (Russian) is welcome. If this is not the case, an additional summary (translation of the abstract) in the other working language will be put at the end of the paper by the organizers or – if possible – by the author(s).
6. In case your abstract is accepted, your paper will receive an ID number, which you have to use instead of the paper ID mask MES2018-XX (see the paper template).
7. If the criteria mentioned in the point (2) are not met, the work can still qualify for a business presentation. In this case, an accompanying paper can also be published, but this is not necessary. 8. Maximum two papers/presentations (of any kind) are allowed with the authorship of the same person (translation of the paper in the other working language does not count for an additional paper).
9. By submitting the paper for publication, the author(s) state that:
 - a) they are presenting original material not previously published or not submitted for publication to any other conference, journal or book;
 - b) they have got all the necessary permissions to show third-party proprietary materials and information, to use business names, or to make reference to them;
 - c) they transfer the copyright to the organizers of the conference – the National Polytechnic University of Armenia (NPUA) and the American University of Armenia (AUA).
10. The organizers of the conference can by no means be held liable for any information published, presented or disclosed in any other way by the conference participants or attendees, disregarding the permissions they have got or had to get from the respective third parties.
